<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talking negatively behind someone's back • Poor sportsmanship/ minor namecalling: in sports, games, or cooperative learning • Disruptive behavior: running in the hall, excessive noise 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mistreating other's property • Pushing/running into other students roughly/jabbing • Threatening to break something • Use of explicit or inappropriate language, not targeted at an individual • Namecalling based on body shape or size, what one has or doesn't have • Exclusion or threatening to exclude • Starting or spreading rumors • Negative or rude gestures towards another student: sticking out tongue, "loser" gesture 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stealing other's property • Swearing at someone; giving "the finger" • Touching/kicking private parts of other students • Severe namecalling: based on disability/race/gender/religion • Threatening to hurt someone • Severe hitting: shoving/slapping/punching/kicking/spitting • Weapons • Credible threat to school or others • Assault • Harassment • Civil rights violations
