

Instructional Model
February 2021



The Sudbury Public Schools surveyed families regarding the factors influencing their choice of instructional model. The intention of the survey was to better understand the community's priorities in terms of mitigation strategies and in-person instruction.

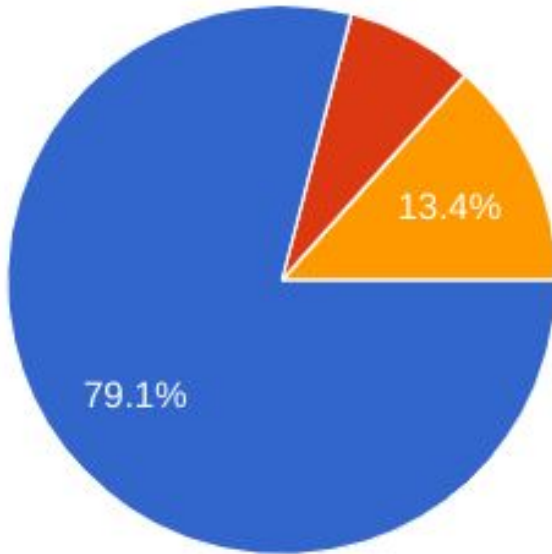
Demographics

1480 respondents on behalf of 1326 students

- 86.5% of respondents had students in either the Hybrid A or B model
 - (78% of SPS students are in Hybrid A or B)
- 5.9% of respondents had students in the Hybrid C model
 - (7% of SPS students are in Hybrid C)
- 12.8% of respondents had students in the Remote model
 - (15% of SPS students are Remote)
- Reference: SPS has 1712 families

Instructional Model

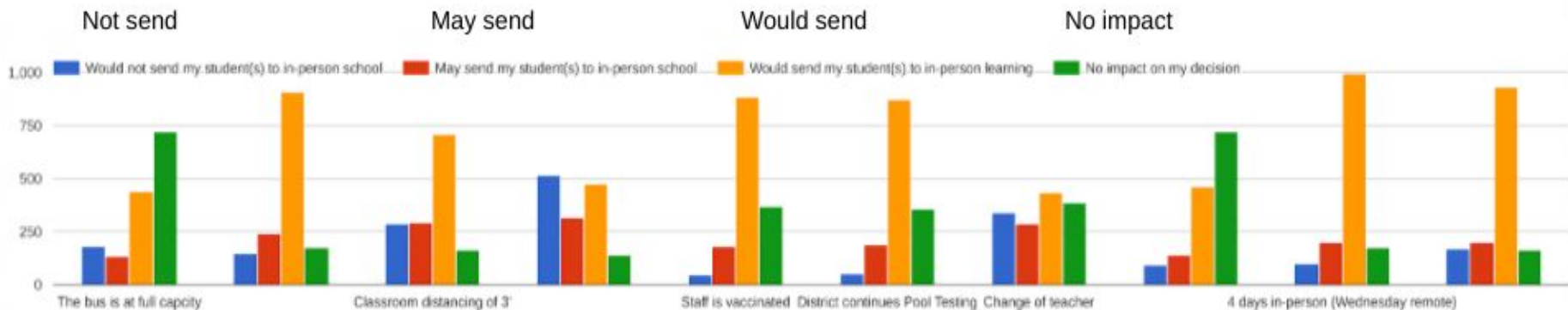
When asked whether they would consider sending their student to school if in-person learning was increased... (7.9% answered "No")
